He made it his life's mission to ensure that the priceless heritage of manuscripts was properly preserved, studied and made available to the scholars. The top view of the building is of the shape of boat. The whole building is only made of concrete. Not even a single brick is used in construction which gives us the view of engineering marvel. The library consists of a large number of books out of which 5000 books are the rarest books which are not available anywhere. The books are available in 18+ language. 40% of the books available there are religious books. More over trainees also got a chance to have a look of tad patri (palm leaf), Tamra patri (copper plates). Inscription by liquid gold as ink was eye witnessed. 3. ECS Services

- 12.1. ECS shall indemnify defend and hold the Customer, its employees, officers and directors against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising out of or in relation to breach of the ECS's representations and warranties.
- 12.2. The Customer shall indemnify, defend, hold harmless and settle at its own expense, any action or other proceeding brought against ECS, to the extent that such action or proceeding is based on Customer's representations and warranties becoming false and breach of the Customer's obligations hereunder.

13. Force Majeure:

- 13.1. Force Majeure means any event or a combination of event that materially or adversely affect the performance of either Parties of its obligation ("Affected Party") in whole or in part, pursuant to the terms of this Agreement but only to the extent that such event or circumstances are not within the Affected Party's reasonable control and have not been caused by willful neglect or act or omission of the Affected Party. The following events shall constitute Force Majeure: epidemic, nuclear emergency, earthquake, riot, war, acts of terrorist.
- 13.2. The Affected Party shall as soon as possible and no later than Thirty (30) days after occurrence of Force Majeure, provide written notice thereof to the other Party.
- 13.3. The Affected Party shall provide the other Party with prompt notice of cessation of the Force Majeure event and resume its obligations as contained

herein.

13.4. In the event Force Majeure continues unabated for an uninterrupted period of 180 days either Party has a right to terminate this Agreement by providing prior written notice.

14. Term and Termination

- 14.1. This Agreement, unless otherwise terminated earlier, shall be effective for a period of 3 years from the Effective Date. The Parties may renew the Agreement for further periods by mutually agreeing to the terms of renewal.
- 14.2. Either party may terminate the Agreement without assigning any reason upon thirty (30) days' advance written notice. In such event, subject to the other terms contained herein, the Customer shall pay for Services rendered through to the date of such termination and ECS shall fulfill its obligations undertaken prior to the termination of this Agreement.
- 14.3. Either Party may terminate the Agreement if the other Party commits a material breach of the Agreement. However, if the material breach is capable of rectification, the party suffering the breach shall be entitled to terminate only after giving one month written notice to the other party stating the details of the breach and on such breach not being cured within the thirty (30) days' notice period.
- 14.4. Either Party may terminate the Agreement forthwith by written notice if the other party is adjudged insolvent or bankrupt, or upon the institution of any proceedings by or against the other party seeking relief, reorganization or arrangement under any laws relating to insolvency, or upon any assignment for the benefit of creditors, or upon the appointment of a receiver, liquidator or trustee of any of the other party's property or assets, or upon liquidation, dissolution or winding up of the other Party's business.
- 14.5. Upon termination of Agreement (i) ECS shall cease to provide the Services; and (ii) The Customer shall pay ECS for the Services rendered till the date of termination;
- 14.6. Termination shall not affect either Party's rights or liabilities accrued prior to the termination of this Agreement.
- 14.7. Clauses 4, 10, 11 and 12 shall survive termination or expiration of this Agreement.

15. Notice

15.1. Any notice, invoice, approval, advice, report or any other communication required to be given to a Party hereunder shall be addressed and delivered to the place of business of such Party as set out in the Preamble of this Agreement or at such other address as may be communicated by such Party to the other Party from time to time for this purpose.

16. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution:

16.1. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with laws in India.

Parties agree that in the event any dispute or breach arising out of or in relation to this Agreement shall be referred exclusively to arbitration to be conducted by a sole arbitrator in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Ahmedabad and the language of arbitration shall be English. The decision of the arbitrator shall be binding on the parties and the parties undertake not to dispute the same. The Parties shall mutually appoint the arbitrator and such appointment shall be official and award passed by the said arbitrator shall be binding on both the parties.

- 16.2. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Parties may apply to any court of competent jurisdiction for a temporary restraining order, preliminary injunction, or other interim or conservatory relief, as necessary, and without abridging any of the powers of the arbitration panel and such an action shall not constitute abrogation of the agreement contained herein.
- 16.3. Any disputes arising out of this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at AhmedabadS, India only.

17. Miscellaneous

17.1. Assignment

17.1.1. This Agreement will bind and inure to the benefit of each Party's successors and assigns, provided that no Party may assign the Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party. Any permitted assignee shall agree in writing to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth herein. Any attempt to assign this Agreement without such consent will be null and void.

17.2. Amendment and waiver

17.2.1. No amendment, modification or waiver of this Agreement shall be valid or consent to departures from the provisions hereof, may be given unless evidenced in writing and signed by authorized representatives of the Parties. A failure or delay to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute waiver hereof.

17.3. Severability

(1)

17.3.1. If at any time one or more provision of this Agreement becomes invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall survive and remain in full force and effect. The parties shall endeavor in good faith to mutually discuss and include replacement provision to the Agreement to carry out the intention of the parties.

With a wonderful PowerPoint Presentation, he exemplified what does NEP includes, what type of vision are there in NEP, principles of NEP and much more.

Shortly after the release of the policy, the government clarified that the language policy in NEP is a broad guideline; and that it was up to the states, institutions and schools to decide the implementation. A more detailed language strategy would be released in the National Curriculum Framework in 2021. Note was also made that there were already institutions which had implemented this language policy 60 years ago such as Sardar Patel Vidyalaya. Both the Education Policy of 1986 and the Right to Education Act, 2009 promoted usage of the mother tongue too as an advisory guideline.

The main goal of NEP 2020 is to ensure opportunity to all children. For gifted children arrangements must be made differently. Education should be focused on conceptual scale rather than rote learning. NEP2020 evaluation system depicts student centric method as well as CCE.

Dr. K. H. Yadav (taskforce,chairperson,Offg. Principal, AGTC) delivered a welcome speech and played an instrumental role in successful conduction of the webinar.



for the three projects, as also assistance for hostel equipment will be released on receipt of project-wise utilisation certificate from the State Government to the extent of 75% of the instalment being hereby released and corresponding physical progress of work. Assistance for computer equipment will be relevant of provision of dust-free accommodation, trained manpower, etc.

- 4. Central assistance for recurring items of expenditure for the above projects will be released on receipt of institution-wise report from the State Government on progress towards creation and filling up of additional posts in these institutions and undertaking of various activities envisaged for CTE in the Guidelines by them.
- 5. The above grant of Central assistance is subject to the following conditions:
 - i) Projects will be implemented, expenditure incurred and activities undertaken by the three institutions in conformity with the guidelines circulated to all State Governments vide D.D. letter No.7-7/87-TE-I dated 4-12-87 of this Department (hereafter referred to as 'the Guidelines') and such other guidelines as may be circulated in future.
 - ii) Recruitment of staff in future will be done according to the eligibility criteria recommended in the above Guidelines to which State Govt, have agreed. Staff will be recruited as early as possible, and will be assured a minimum tenure of 3 years.
 - iii) All new buildings will be designed and constructed in the most economical manner possible. Suitable innovative designs, techniques and building material will be used to achieve this objective. In any case, building work will be taken up in such a manner as to be completed uithin the cost coiling indicated in the Annex.
 - iv) The responsibility for maintenance of buildings and equipment to be constructed/procured by the institutions with assistance being hereby provided and for other items mentioned in para 1.8 of the Guidelines shall be of the institutions themselves.

- v) As from the academic year 1989-90, the STEIs being upgraded will limit their intake in such a manner that the pupil-teacher ratio does not exceed 12, on the basis of the number of teaching posts in the institutions before upgradation.

the Guidelines. Pay scales of these posts will be dotermined by the State Government, keeping in view the recommendations contained in the Guidalines in this regard. The above three categories of posts at present existing in the institutions selected for upgradation (whether carrying these or other equivalent designation) will, as the case may be, upgraded, retained or abolished, and additional posts to the extent necessary will be created so that these institutions have posts of these three categories as indicated in the said Annexure III. For items of recurring expanditure, that is pay and allowances of the staff as per Annexure III of the Guidelines and expenses incurred on organising various programmes in the CTE/IASE contral assistance will be provided unto the end of 1989-90 to the extent of actual requirement reduced by the level of expenditure already being incurred by the State Covernment/institutions during the rred by the State Government/institutions during the year 1988-89. Expenditure, on any posts other than those indicated in the said Annexure III will be wholly the responsibility of the institutions concerned. Assistance for additional posts to the above extent would be available from the month the Pupil Teacher Ratio is adjusted in accordance with (v) above.

- vii) The Shikshan Mahavidyalaya, Gujerat Vidyapith, already has a faculty strength which is about the same as given for a CTE in the guidelines. Question of approval of 1989-90, after it has re-fixed its intake in accordance with (v) above. In any case, additional posts for it would be sanctioned only to the extent permitted by the in the Guidelines. Recurring assistance for inservice available to this institution as indicated for the other two institutions under (vi) above.
- viii) All Central ascissonce for the institutions shall be routed through the State Govt. which shall be responsite for over seeing its proper utilisation and for ensuring performance by the institutions of functions sing the first instalment of Central assistance to these institutions, the State Govt. shall obtain from should be duly enforceable in law, to the effect that the Central and State Govts. in connection with the Scheme, and will perform functions expected of them their failure to do so, all Central assistance paid to the small become liable for being recovered.
 - ix) The amount of grant shall be utilised only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and the unspent shall be refunded by the State

- x) Hostels to be constructed with the assistance being hereby sanctioned shall be used primirly/accommodating hereby sanctioned shall be used primirly/accommodating serving teachers coming for in-service training programmes of upto a month duration and will be used programmes of upto a month duration courses only for persons undergoing longer duration courses only to the extent hostels seats are not needed for the former category of programmes, which would be former category of programmes, which would be organised on the scale envisaged in the quidelines.
- xi) A copy of every order of the State Government or institutions' Management according administrative approval or financial sanction for any item of non-approval or recurring expanditure (including orders recurring posts) in connection with the above projects shall be endorsed to this Department.
- xii) The State Government will immediately get developed standard lists and specifications for the categories of equipment specified in the Annex. to this sanction and purchases shall be made according to such standard lists/specifications.

Copies of standard lists/specifications developed as above will be sent to this Department and to the Head, Department of Teacher Education, NCERT, within a month from the issue of this sanction

- 6. The net expenditure of Rs. 69.80 lakhs referred to in para 4 above will be debited to Demand No. 45-Department of Education Major Head "3601" F. Grants-in-aid to the State Governments, F.2-Grants for Central Plan Schemes, F. 2(i)(1)-Strengthening of Taahoer Training Institutions (Plan) 1988-89. Additional funds will be provided by reappropriation in due course.
- 7. The pattern of grant/expenditure has been approved by the Ministry of finance. This conction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Finance.
