**Prof. Viralben Jadav** suggested revising paper titles to align with NCTE and UGC guidelines, separating practical work and practice teaching into separate sections.

Dr. Nitinkumar Dhadhodara emphasized the importance of assigning weightage to each unit and ensuring unit titles accurately reflect subtopics.

Dr. Pathik Barot recommended replacing "assignment" with "field engagement" and utilizing in-house resources for book reviews and film reviews.

**Dr. Sandip Boricha** discussed authentic resources for IKS and stressed the need to adhere to TAT/TAT guidelines when preparing language paper syllabi.

Ms. Suhani Parekh proposed incorporating MOOC courses and conducting internal exams without disrupting semester-end exams.

**Dr. Nirav Thakkar** shared insights on NCF-SC and credit framework guidelines, highlighting the allocation of hours for theory and practical work.

The members collectively reviewed and provided valuable feedback, emphasizing the need for Program Outcomes, Course Outcomes, and Learning Outcomes to be interconnected and uniformly patterned across each course. Following the general discussion, the members divided into groups to discuss pedagogical syllabus, gathering valuable suggestions. The BOS reviewed and approved the syllabus for Semester I and Semester II. It was resolved that the finalized syllabus would be circulated among faculty for implementation in the upcoming academic session. The implementation will begin from the academic year 2025–26.

**Dr. K.H. Yadav** expressed gratitude to all members for their valuable contributions and active participation. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks.
